# 2023-2024 North Carolina U.S. Presidential Scholars General Education Application Form

Application must be completed by student and submitted to district Administrator/School Personnel for further consideration.

Nomination packets MUST be submitted to NCDPI by district or charter personnel, NOT by the student or parent.

(Confirmation of receipt via email within 24 hours) NCDPI state-level nominations are due to the U.S. Commission on Presidential Scholars November 30, 2023 U.S. Commission announces all State nominees and invites them to apply mid-January 2024 Nominee applications are due to the U.S. Commission February 2024 U.S Commission announces the 2024 Semifinalists April 2024 U.S. Commission announces the 2024 U.S. Presidential Scholars early-May 2024 State Board of Education recognizes the U.S. Presidential Scholars selected from early-June 2024 North Carolina

#### **Process:**

- Students will confirm due date of initial application with local school district.
- Students will submit completed application to local PSU (public school unit).
- PSU's will evaluate applications, verify student test scores, and select final nominations for the PSU (number of eligible nominees is based on senior student enrollment\*).
- PSU's will submit final nomination packet to the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction (NCDPI) –
   Office of Advanced Learning and Gifted Education for further consideration. NCDPI will send a confirmation
   receipt to the email sender within 24 hours.
- NCDPI will evaluate all candidate nomination packet and documents.
- NCDPI will submit the names of twenty State nominees (10 males and 10 females) to the U.S. Commission on Presidential Scholars by November 30, 2023.
- All State nominees will be added to the larger pool of nominees from across the United States. Finalists are announced, and then invited to apply directly to the U.S. Commission on Presidential Scholars in mid-January 2024.
- Completed applications will be due in February, and final U.S. Presidential Scholars will be announced by early-May 2024.

Describe what qualities make an effective leader. Include a specific example of when you took a leadership role to either solve a problem or to create something of value (3000 characters max).
Describe what special challenges or hurdles you have overcome while still achieving high academic success (3000 characters max).

### **District Administrator/School Personnel:**

To be considered, all nomination packets (application with all three parts including any supporting documents) must be completed with signatures and received digitally by **5:00 pm on Friday**, **November 3, 2023** using the following process:

- 1. District/school must verify the SAT and/or ACT test scores and grade point average (GPA) prior to submitting the student's nomination packet.
- 2. Compile each student nomination packet as a separate digital file.
- Name each file according to the following nomenclature: (PSU) Presidential ScholarsNomination - (Last Name of Student).

For example: Pender Presidential Scholars Nomination - Smith
