
K-12 World Languages

The 2024 North Carolina Standard Course of Study for World Languages is intended to cultivate proficiency and intercultural competence in a classical, heritage, or modern language and help develop globally collaborative students. The ability to communicate in multiple languages has cognitive, economic, educational, and sociocultural benefits, ensuring students will be competitive in post-secondary pursuits-- college, career, or military-- and throughout their lives.

The standards emphasize the three modes of communication (interpretive, interpersonal, and presentational), and highlight the importance of making literacy, interdisciplinary, intercultural, and community connections through each of these modes of communication. The standards are based on the structure of the *World-Readiness Standards for Learning Languages* from the national language organization, ACTFL, formerly called the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages.

Additionally, these standards are proficiency-based and describe what learners can do with language at each proficiency level and with each skill. Proficiency and skill-mastery progress differently due to a number of factors, including continuity of study and program design, exposure to the language outside of school, and international experiences, among others.

To account for these variations, and embed multiple entry points across the K-12 spectrum, the objectives in these standards are organized by proficiency level, rather than grade level, using the ACTFL proficiency scale, pictured here as an inverted pyramid. Minimum proficiency outcome charts are available as support documents to show what students should know and be able to do by the end of a course or grade span when they hear, sign, speak, read, view, or write the language they are studying in the various K-12 programs in Classical Languages, Dual Language/Immersion & Heritage Languages, and Modern Languages, including American Sign Language (ASL).



These standards and objectives are not intended to be the curriculum, nor do they indicate the whole of a curriculum which will be written by a local public school unit (PSU) or school. The standards have been developed to serve as the framework to guide each PSU in developing curriculum for K-12 World Language courses and programs, and the proficiency level objectives show the minimum student outcomes for each skill.
