The East Union Middle School team analyzed the following school data from 2013-14 and 2014-15: I.EOG/EOC results including 1) goal summaries by teacher, grade level and district, 2) EVAAS growth scores by student, subgroup, teacher, school and district and, 3) CCR and GLP status II. TWC survey results and local student, teacher, and parent survey results III. Attendance data IV. Discipline data V. Promotion data

The data analysis reveals that: 1) for two years, the school has not met ecpected growth, but has improved the overall growth score from -4.89 to -2.75. 2) the white students continue all other subgroups and the highest proficiency scores ar in 8th grade science 3) the school remains committed to instructional work through Professional Learning Communities, Response to Instruction, and the integration of technology into the classroom 4) the school has maintined a >95% attendance average for the past four years, 5) Crime and Violence incidents and short term suspensions are more than double the district and state average, while long term suspensions are more in line with district and state averages.
