Our staff used EOG results to make the following determinations; 1) Our students demonstrated an overall proficiency of 34% during 2014 - 2015. 2) Our students did NOT met expected growth during 2014 - 2015.3) Reading and Math Proficiency combined decreased in all groups except BLACK during the 2014 - 2015 school year. All this performance data can be directly linked to student discipline concerns and lack of student engagement. During the 2014 - 2015 school year Walter Bickett Elementary documented 1,500 student office referrals and nearly 300 student out of school suspensions. This information indicated a need to address student discipline and increase the level of student engagement. Walter Bickett Elementary is currently comprised of a largely minority population which includes 48% Hispanic, 39% Black, 8% White, 4% Other and 1% Asian Students. Our school is has 95% of students receiving free or reduced lunch. The staff at Walter Bickett Elementary consists of 67 certified staff members. Twenty-eight percent of those staff members are Beginning Teachers and 20% of the staff is new to WBES during the 2015 - 2016 School Year.
