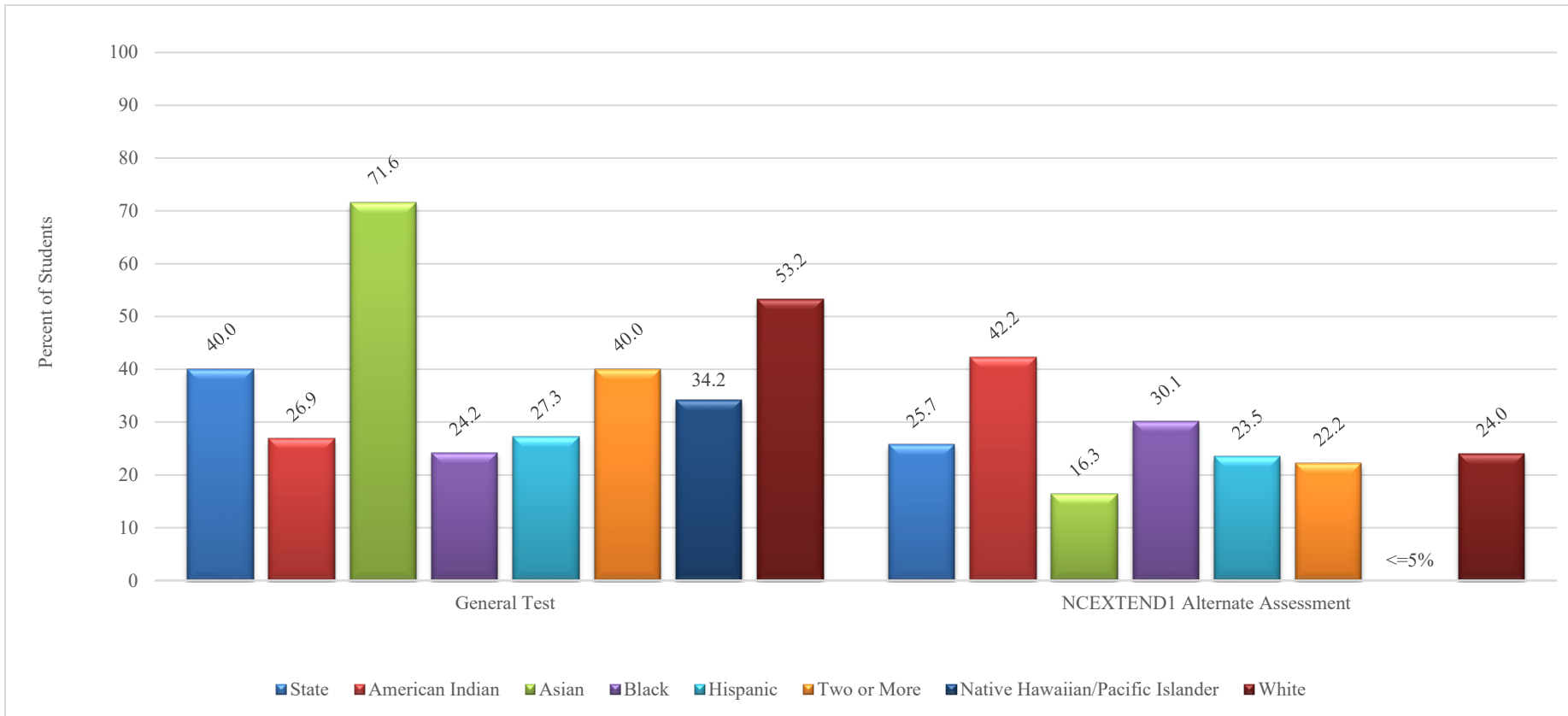

Grades 3–8 by Test Type and Ethnicity**



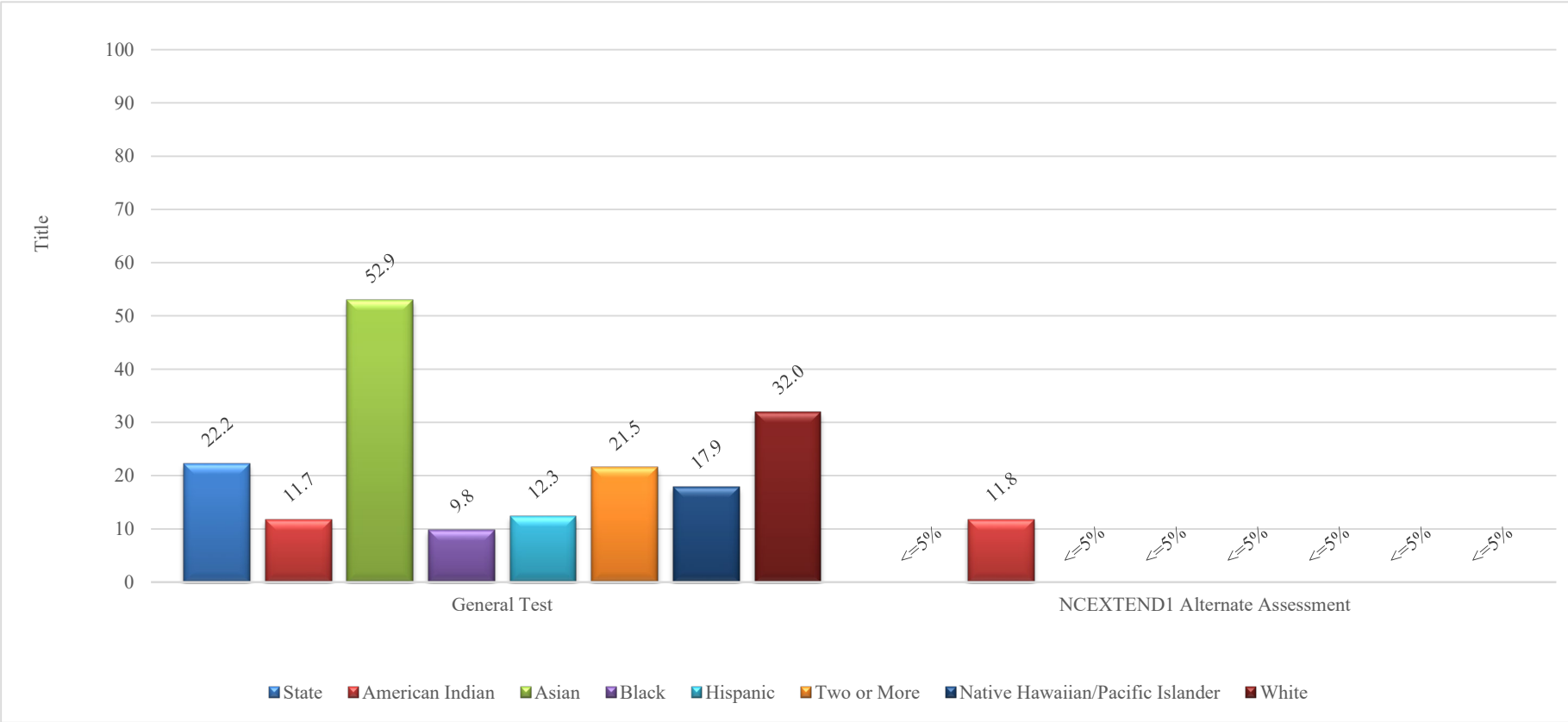

Grades 3–8 by Test Type and Ethnicity**



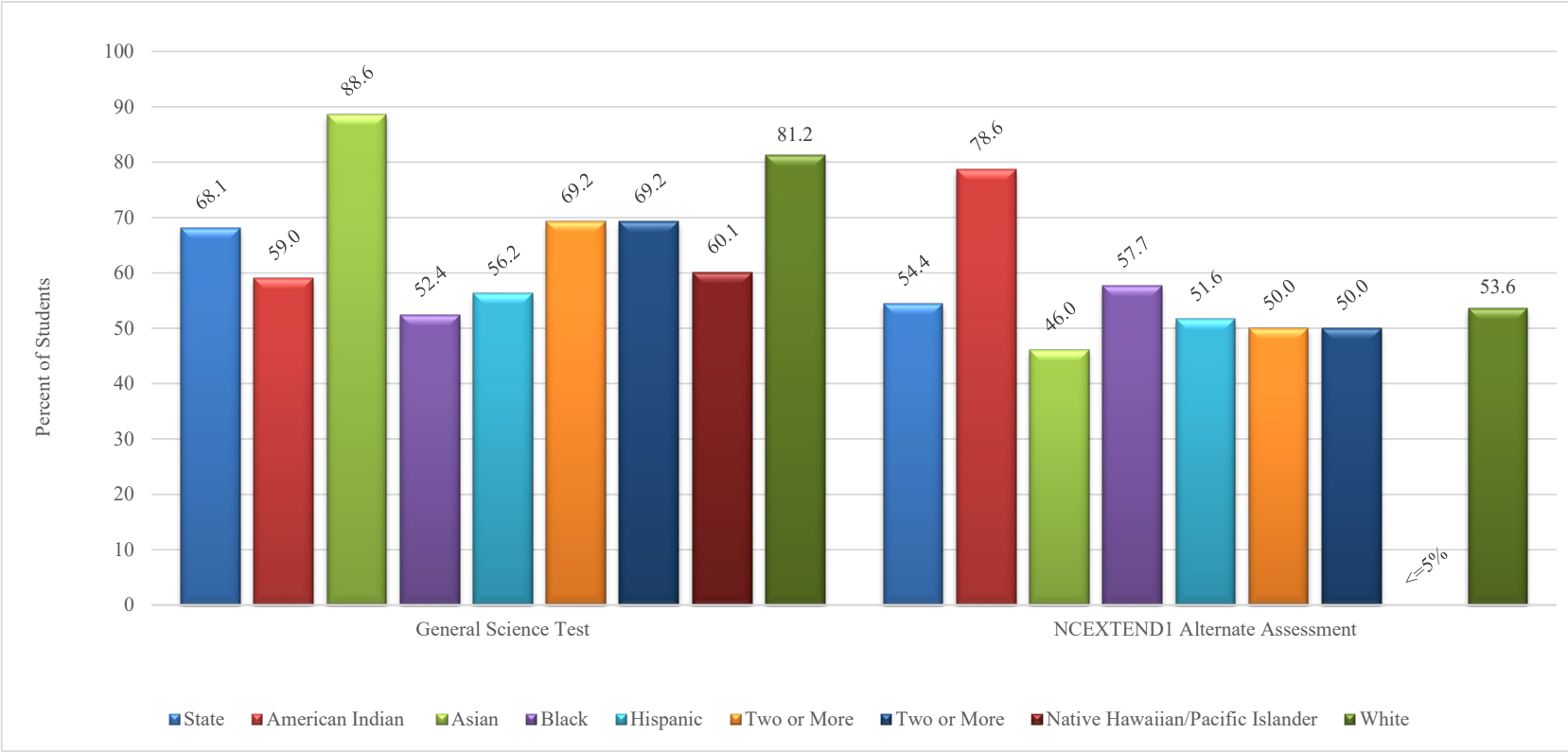

Grades 5 and 8 Combined by Test Type and Ethnicity**



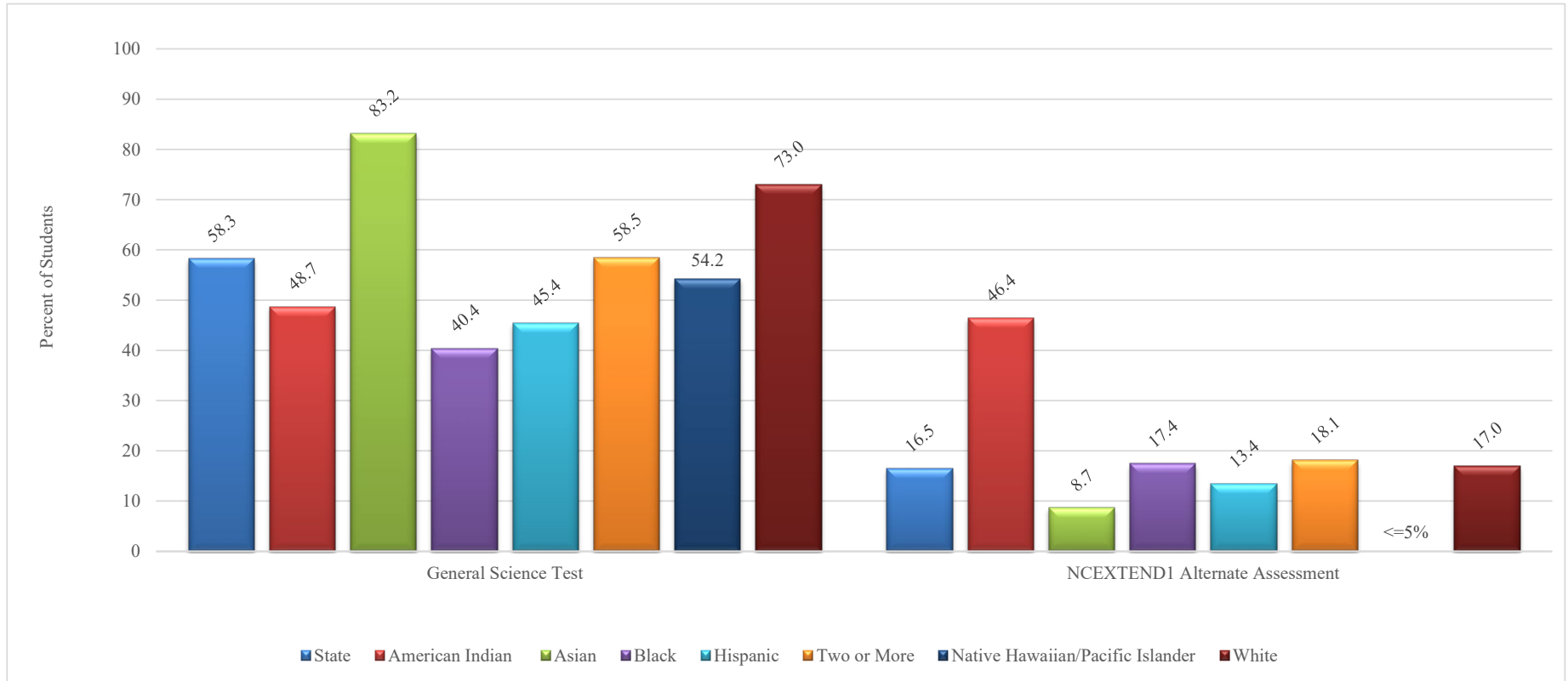
