

This Individual Student Report provides information about your student's score on the College and Career Readiness Alternate Assessment (CCRAA) at Grade 10. The CCRAA at Grade 10 is an alternative assessment to the PreACT<sup>™</sup>. All students in grade 10 are required to take either the PreACT<sup>™</sup> or the CCRAA. The CCRAA is available to eligible students who are following a course of study that upon completing high school may not lead to admission into a college-level course of study resulting in a college degree.

The CCRAA at Grade 10 is a 43-item test that assesses similar subject areas as the PreACT<sup>™</sup> including high school English, math, reading, and science. Your student received a combined score for all subject areas.
