


Example Response Space for End-of-Course Test of English II

This is an example of the response space available to record an answer to a constructed response item on an English II test.

For the short answer questions, you will write your responses on the lines provided in your test book. Use the lines in your test book as a guideline for your response. Your response can be up to 1000 characters in length. A character is defined as one letter, number, punctuation symbol or a single space between letters, numbers, and punctuation symbols.
