Overview

This supplemental information is provided in addition to *The North Carolina Graduation Project: Standards of Quality and Verification Process for High School Accountability* (published Fall 2018) for school test coordinators to ensure the general statutes below are met in public school units where the Graduation Project is implemented.

§G.S. 115C-12 (9d) b. 2

The Board shall not require any student to prepare a high school graduation project as a condition of graduation from high school; local boards of education may, however, require their students to complete a high school graduation as provided in G.S. 115C-47(54a).

§G.S. 115C-47 (54a)

To ensure funding for graduation projects. A local board of education shall not require a high school graduation project as a condition of graduation from high school unless the board provides from local funds a method of reimbursement of up to seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) for expenses related to the high school graduation project for any student identified as an economically disadvantaged student.
