

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Core SEL Competencies

Social and emotional learning (SEL) is the process through which children and adults understand and manage emotions, set and achieve positive goals, feel and show empathy for others, establish and maintain positive relationships, and make responsible decisions (CASEL).



Research on SEL indicates connections with achievement and an overall **impact** on students.

Summary of NC SEL Implementation Plan

BUILD FOUNDATIONAL SUPPORT & PLAN



North Carolina has created an implementation plan for scaling up integrated social emotional learning across our state. We are establishing our working groups; developing a shared, statewide vision; assessing our needs and resources; developing our communication plan; and aligning our resources and policies.

STRENGTHEN ADULT SEL COMPETENCIES & CAPACITY



North Carolina is developing adult expertise on SEL through our professional learning systems. We will create conditions to support SEL across the educator pipeline; strengthen adult social and emotional competence and leadership to advance SEL through collaboration with districts, communities, and families; and promote equity through SEL.

PROMTE SEL FOR STUDENTS



North Carolina is promoting and supporting adoption and implementation of evidence-based programs and practices and promoting SEL integration with academic standards and other school based frameworks. We will support implementation of Prek-12 SEL competencies; develop and strengthen family partnerships through policies, systems, and supports; and develop and strengthen SEL-related community partnerships.

USE DATA FOR CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT



North Carolina is creating a state-level SEL Data Evaluation Plan to include mapping existing student outcome and adult implementation data. We will develop strategies and tools for supporting SEL implementation for continuous improvement using a problem solving model.
