Dual Credit Allowances for Career and College Promise

In March 2016, the NC Community College System announced the addition of UGETC courses ENG 241 British Literature I, ENG 242 British Literature II, and MAT 272 Calculus II to the Career and College Promise (CCP) transfer pathway course offerings.

With this additional course availability to all CCP students, NCDPI has updated the Dual Credit Allowances chart to include these courses for high school dual credit, effective immediately.

Effective with the summer session:

- High school students who enroll in and pass ENG 111, ENG 112 and ENG 241 or 242 through CCP will satisfy their English IV high school graduation requirement.
- Students who enroll in and pass ENG 111, ENG 112, ENG 231 or 232, and ENG 241 or 242 will satisfy both English III and IV high school graduation requirements.
- High school students who enroll in and pass MAT 272 will satisfy their fourth mathematics high school graduation requirement.

Please see the attached updated **Dual Credit Allowances** chart for a complete list of the UGETC courses and their dual credit allowances for high school. These courses will be programmed into Powerschool high school graduation plan and UNC minimum admissions early in the 2016-17 academic year.
