

<p>How do we proceed if a parent is angry and wants an IEP meeting held and the eligibility is expired but we can't finalize the IEP? With the closure last year, we are still catching up on evals that were open.</p>	<p>First, a request for an IEP Team meeting should be honored. Then, there are a couple of options.</p> <p>1- Consider whether contracting for evaluations may be extremely overdue given the backlog. -OR-</p> <p>2- Review the reevaluation that is in progress and determine whether it was for programming or for eligibility. If for programming, the IEP Team can determine whether the review of existing data supports continued eligibility in the current disability category. If true, then, finalize the eligibility. Once the evaluation for programming is completed, the IEP Team should meet, add the results from the evaluation for programming to the PLAAFP, and determine whether revisions to the IEP are required. Then, finalizing the IEP should be able to be accomplished. -OR-</p> <p>3- <i>(not ideal; however, preferred over a dispute)</i> Hold the IEP Team meeting, draft in ECATS any changes into an addendum IEP, print off the addendum and cross through the "Proposed" watermark and mark "Final". Provide the parent the meeting copy of this final addendum. While you won't be able to finalize, you will have kept the EC processes moving forward and in compliance with reviewing and revising the IEP when there is a concern. Then, you can finalize once eligibility is resolved.</p>
<p>Do we know when the charter headcount transfer system will open up?</p>	<p>The EC division is working closely with school business to have the most efficient process for determining charter school headcount transfers. If the methodology requires a manual submission, your charter RC will notify you well in advance of the timelines.</p>
