Use of Assessment/Evaluation Codes

In anticipation of the potential need for multiple assessment cycles for some students in the coming school year, Division of Health Benefits (DHB)/NC Medicaid has clarified that assessment codes are reimbursable no more frequently than every 6 months, given all other policy requirements are met. This should not impact educational decision-making.

Removal of Parent Consent and Physician Order Tracking

In the coming weeks/months, tracking of one-time parental consent and physician orders will be phased out of the ECATS Service Documentation module. LEAs will need to arrange for these functions with their third-party billing vendors.
