Updating Board Information In EDDIE- Deadline Extended!!

EDDIE is the authoritative source for NC public school numbers and demographic information, and is used by multiple systems including; <u>Accountability</u>, <u>PowerSchool</u>, <u>NC School Report Cards</u>, and used to meet federal reporting requirements.

Last year we collected board member information using a word document, and when schools made changes, they had to resubmit the form. In order to streamline our collection of board membership data, all charter schools now will enter/update the current Board Chair and Board Vice Chair in the EDDIE system. Keeping the Board Chair and Vice Chair information current will help NCDPI communicate effectively with current school administrators and board members. If your school has changes to Board Chair, Board Vice Chair, or any other school demographic information, please be sure to update this information in EDDIE!

Please update your Board Chair and Vice Chair <u>by November 30</u>, <u>2015</u>. Step-by-step instructions for completing this update are as follows:

- 2. Log into EDDIE (note: only approved users may log into the system Subscribed User List is posted at http://www.ncpublicschools.org/fbs/accounting/eddie/)
- 3. Look at Selection Options on the Welcome Main Menu page
- 4. Change selection button to Charter/Regional Name
- 5. Select your school in the dropdown, and click GO
- 6. On School Information screen, midway down and to the right, click Edit School Staff
- 7. On School Staff screen, click Create A New Staff Record
- 8. From Staff Title dropdown, select Board Chair or Board Vice Chair
- 9. Complete information and click Save/Create This Staff Record
- 10. Repeat as needed to enter more title information.
- 11. To edit previously entered information, look at the *Staff Title* row to be updated and click on the blue text that says Edit in that row (note: only current school year data can be updated).

Charter schools are responsible for ensuring all their data in EDDIE are complete, accurate, and current. <u>Please also</u> check EDDIE (http://apps.schools.nc.gov/eddie) to <u>ensure that your school's address</u>, telephone number, fax number, contact email, and website information are current.

Charter School Civil and Liability Annual Compliance – December 4, 2015 Deadline!!

NC General Statute 115C-218.20 requires charter schools to hold current, active civil and liability insurance with at least the coverage stated in the Charter Agreement. The Office of Charter Schools asks each school to submit annual proof of insurance. If you have not already complied with this request, please submit your insurance binder to Kristin Jones via email at Kristin.jones@dpi.nc.gov no later than 4:30 p.m. on Friday, December 4, 2015.

PowerSchool Homeless Data Collection Pages Now Open

All public schools in North Carolina are required to provide McKinney-Vento Data. Information about McKinney-Vento can be found on the North Carolina Homeless Education Program webpage at http://www.serve.org/hepnc. All schools must report data on homeless students even if none are enrolled at the school. Please see more specific information regarding this process outlined below:

\$\$200 Full Time Personnel Report –Deadline Extended!!

Both LEAs and <u>Charter Schools must complete this report!</u>

The SS200 Online Report is <u>due by **Monday**</u>, <u>December 7, 2015</u>. The link to the SS200 online application is located at the NCDPI Financial and Business Services website under "What's New": <u>www.ncpublicschools.org/fbs</u>.

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The SS200 Full-Time Personnel Report is an online system that collects race/ethnicity, gender and fund source of full-time personnel employed as of October 1 - October 31, for the current school year (2015 – 2016). You may reference your Human Resource Management (HRMS) SS-200 Full-Time Personnel Report to assist in completing this report. The report has historically been captured as of October 1, however LEAs have expressed concern about this date due to the recent passing of the state budget. In response to this concern, for this year's collection you are allowed a range to collect the data and you may report based on any day during October.

The information will be entered online and the individual submitting the report will need a North Carolina Identity Management identification (NCID) login. If you (or your staff) need an NCID, you must contact your LEA NCID administrator to set up an account for you. A directory of the LEA NCID administrators is available at: www.ncid.its.state.nc.us/LEAListing.asp. NCDPI cannot assign an NCID or reset NCID passwords.
