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Home Base Maintenance Weekend - April 21-23, 2017

The next Home Base maintenance weekend is scheduled for tonight, April 21 through Sunday, April 23, 2017. Maintenance will be performed on the PowerSchool, Schoolnet and Performance Matters (Truenorthlogic) applications. Additionally, the Staff and Student UID systems will be unavailable during the Home Base maintenance window.

The PowerSchool application will be brought down Friday evening at 5 p.m. Once maintenance is completed, a message will be sent to notify users that the system is up and available for use.

Schoolnet maintenance will begin tonight at 8 p.m. and last approximately 4 hours. Maintenance will involve running a script to correct item formats, and running the Elastic Searches (ES) to re-index items for Certica Social Studies items that are having grades re-aligned. Performance will be impacted for

those using the application's search feature and could possibly result in incorrect counts on item searches while re-indexing is underway.

The Performance Matters (Truenorthlogic) maintenance will not require an outage; however, during the Staff and Student UID systems' maintenance, it may experience downtimes.

All Home Base applications should be returned to service no later than 6 a.m., Monday, April 24. If there is a delay in bringing up the applications, users will be notified.

OCR/CRDC Submission End Date is April 24, 2017

Dear Superintendents and OCR Coordinators,

DPI has uploaded as much data as possible on your behalf to the USED's Civil Rights Data Collection (CRDC) system. We hope this has been a benefit to you all.



You must **certify**, within the CRDC system that your data is complete and accurate by **Monday April 24**, **2017**. This will require you to enter the CRDC system, address any error messages and officially certify the data. The submission cannot be certified until all errors are corrected. To view your LEA and School Errors and Warnings, click the Reports Link at the top right of the Federal Submission Portal home page. Navigate to the Error Resolution Report for Advanced Users report and click Download Error Resolution Report. We cannot do this on your behalf.

Please forward this email to other staff as appropriate. DPI has communicated throughout this process the status of the upload and the responsibilities of the LEA to verify and certify. Please review the OCR/CRDC spreadsheet containing the OCR Coordinator's name and contact information we have been provided. This is the list we have used to contact your LEA throughout the process. If this contact is not correct, please send us the correct contact information and we will update the list. Note: Those LEAs

and Schools that were not open in the school year 2015-16 are not required to participate in this collection.

At this time, we do not believe there will be any extension of the April 24 deadline.
