## Home Base Maintenance Weekend - Feb. 10-12, 2017

The next Home Base maintenance weekend is scheduled for Friday, February 10, through Sunday, February 12, 2017. PowerSchool will be taken offline Friday, February 10, at 5 p.m. Schoolnet will have a hotfix released from 6 to 8 p.m., tonight. Truenorthlogic will remain available.

Maintenance is expected to last the full length due to several implementations taking place. Once completed for all systems, a message will be sent to notify users that Home Base is up and available for use. All applications will be returned to service no later than 6 a.m., Monday, February 13. If a delay in bringing up the systems should occur, users will be notified via email.

Included in this maintenance weekend is the deployment of PowerSchool 9.2.4.4, Impact on Client Workstation Security. Please review the <u>9.2.4.4 Release Notes</u> located on the NC SIS website for details.

Also, the Student UID System will be refreshed with PowerSchool student data during this weekend's maintenance window. The refresh is part of the efforts to resolve duplicate student records that exist in the PowerSchool and Student UID systems, and will ensure that when duplicate student records are identified and resolved, data is reflected similarly in both systems. **Note that during the maintenance window, the Student UID System will be unavailable.**

## **OCR/CRDC - Phase II Begins**

Phase II (LEAs and Charters working on their data in the Federal Submission Portal) will be delayed until February 20, 2017.

An error was discovered in CRDC Student Aggregations by School, Part 2. Part 2, Question 25, 'School Days Missed Due to Out-of-School Suspension' is calculating number of students rather than total days missed. This error will be resolved during the February

PowerSchool maintenance weekend. The CRDC Part 2 PowerSchool Preview report will be re-run and achieved by the vendor after the update. **No action is required by LEAs or Charter schools.** 

The NC DPI will upload PS data and external data during the week of February 13, 2017. Until the NC DPI upload is complete, LEAs and Charters may log in and create accounts, but should not upload any data. Do not update or add data until notified by the NC DPI.
