Come check out PowerTeacher Pro sessions offered for Administrators and Teachers at the Connecting Communities of Education Stakeholders Conference (CCES)!

PowerTeacher Pro sessions for Administrators are designed for LEA coordinators to learn how to implement PowerTeacher Pro and explore how to create district-level calculation formulas and assignment categories for teachers. Administrators will also learn how to set up grading preferences for both standards-based and traditional grading.

PowerTeacher Pro for Teachers is designed for district/school administrators and teachers to explore the new HTML-based gradebook and its advanced features for both standards-based and traditional grading. Additionally, participants will learn how to set up default preferences, create assignment categories, work with assignments, analyze individual student performance, and run reports included in the gradebook.
