#### **DIT Patching**

The NC Department of Information Technology (DIT) will be performing monthly Windows patching, including the UID System servers, this Sunday, March 4, 2018, between 4:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. The Staff and Student UID systems will be unavailable during this time. Therefore, please do not enroll, transfer and/or update student demographic information in PowerSchool during this period.

### Next Home Base Maintenance Weekend -March 9-12, 2018

The next Home Base maintenance weekend is scheduled for Friday, March 9 through Sunday, March 11, 2018. PowerSchool and Schoolnet are both scheduled for maintenance.

PowerSchool maintenance will involve a North Carolina State Reporting Release for Common Follow-up (CFU) Reporting. In this release, the CFU-3 validation warning will be changed to a fatal error.



Schoolnet anticipates an upgrade release to version 19.1.4. More details concerning this release will be provided at a later date.

Home Base will be brought down on Friday at 5 p.m. and returned to service no later than Monday, March 12 at 6 a.m. Once maintenance is completed, a message will be sent to notify users that the system is up and available for use. If there is a delay in bringing up the applications, users will be notified.
