

Emergency Maintenance for Schoolnet

Due to today's performance issues experienced in Schoolnet, Pearson plans to perform an emergency maintenance **Sunday, March 26, 2017, at 10:00 a.m.** The duration of this maintenance should not exceed one hour.

Maintenance will involve applying a code hot fix to resolve two conflicting queries in the Schoolnet database when online testing peaks; thus, resulting in slow performance and connectivity issues.

All LEAs and Charters may now complete the OCR/CRDC Submission in the Federal Portal.

The NC DPI has completed correcting errors that were generated in the Federal Submission Portal upon upload. After review and update, LEAs and Charters may now certify their data in the Federal Submission Portal.

Please be aware that errors may still exist in some LEAs. The submission may not be certified until all errors are corrected. To see LEA and School Errors and Warnings, click the Reports Link at the top right of the Federal Submission Portal home page. Navigate to the Error Resolution Report for Advanced Users report and click Download Error Resolution Report.

All collections must be certified by April 24, 2017.

PowerScheduler Regional Working Sessions (Build & Load, Load Only)

**Please note, all registration information is subject to North Carolina Public Records Law.

Attendees must be an employee of a North Carolina public school. Management companies and their employees are not permitted to attend.

The "Build and Load" session is designed for schools building a master schedule using PowerScheduler. Prior to attending this session, schools MUST complete at minimum, steps A-H in the "PowerScheduler: Prepare to Build" workbook. Having the build data validated and errors cleared before attending is recommended. Schools will work with their scheduling teams to complete the build and load processes to the extent that time allows.

The "Load Only" session is designed for schools planning to copy their master schedule, and loading students into courses. Prior to attending this session, schools MUST complete at minimum, steps A-G in the "PowerScheduler: Load Process". Schools will work with their scheduling teams to complete the load processes to the extent that time allows.

These workshops are not intended to be a training session. They are hands-on work sessions; schools should plan to send all personnel needed to complete the build and load processes and/or load processes. Up to 4 people per school may attend.

Only the LEA/Charter SIS Coordinator or designee may register their schools for sessions. Note, only 1 school per LEA may sign up per regional "Build and Load" and "Load Only" sessions. For example, an LEA may send up to three schools per week (one school Monday-Tuesday Build and Load, one school Wednesday for Load Only, and

one school Thursday-Friday Build and Load). It is only necessary to create one registration for each school - not one for each person that may attend. Each registration allows 4 people from that school to attend.

Attendees are to bring a laptop to each session and make sure that the latest PowerScheduler Engine is Loaded before coming to the session.

**Please note, NCDPI has the right to combine sessions if not enough attendees register.

Sessions run 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. each day with lunch on your own.
