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Home Base Maintenance Weekend Activities - Sept. 14-16

This weekend is a planned Home Base maintenance weekend. PowerSchool is the only Home Base tool scheduled for maintenance.



PowerSchool maintenance will entail modifying the AIG collection to resolve an issue with the AIG report not showing students enrolled prior to or on April 15 in the Spring AIG Headcount. Once applied, students who are enrolled prior to or on April 15 will be counted in the Spring AIG Headcount.

PowerSchool will be taken offline today, September 14 at 5 p.m. and returned to service no later than Monday, September 17 at 6 a.m. Once maintenance is completed, a message will be sent to notify users that the application is up and available for use. If there is a delay in bring up the system, users will be notified.
