Home Base Maintenance Weekend for September 2016 - Update

The next Home Base maintenance weekend is scheduled for Friday, September 16 through Sunday, September 18. Maintenance will be performed on the PowerSchool, Schoolnet and Truenorthlogic (TNL) applications. The TNL and Schoolnet maintenance will occur within the time frame of the PowerSchool maintenance.

PowerSchool will shut down Friday, at 5 p.m. Once maintenance is completed, a message will be sent to notify users that the system is up and available for use. PowerSchool will be returned to service no later

than 6 a.m., Monday morning. If a delay in bringing up the system should occur, users will be notified via email.

This maintenance weekend will include a State Compliance Reporting release. Updates will be made to PowerSchool Civil Rights Data Collection Preview Reports (see below), RPG Collection, Common Follow Up Collection (see below) and Drop Out Collection. For more details concerning these revisions, please review the 2016 North Carolina Release Notes.

Security Fix for Group 1 Unassigned:

A security fix for Group 1 Unassigned Security Access will be deployed into PowerSchool this maintenance weekend. This fix will prevent users from assigning or changing a security group with privileges higher than their own. It will also prevent any user with a group level of 1 from making security group changes.

Common Follow Up Fix:

Any Common Follow Up reports run after the completion of this maintenance weekend will no longer recognize final mark fields that are left blank (e.g., fields with dots or dashes). If you have already run the CFU Report, please re-run it prior to approval. If your report has been approved, please un-approve, re-run and approve it again.

Schoolnet Hot Fix:

A hot fix will be deployed into Schoolnet tonight, at 8:00 p.m., to correct an identified issue with TestNav integration. The issue relates to a bottleneck on the API between Schoolnet and TestNav under high volumes of TestNav testing. North Carolina has not reported this issue; however, this fix is being put in place as a preventative measure.

The expected duration of deployment is 90 minutes. Performance of any work requiring the user to save (e.g., new test creation, new or edits to instructional materials) during this time frame is NOT recommended.

PowerSchool CRDC Preview Reports:

The maintenance weekend will provide the first iteration of the PowerSchool CRDC Preview reports, and will also release the latest version of the CRDC LEA and School screens. A webinar will be hosted by the NCDPI to discuss the upcoming collection on Friday, September 23, 2016 from 9:30 a.m. -11:30 a.m. Use the following link to register for this

OCR/CRDC - Coordinator Contact Reminder

The Office of Civil Rights (OCR) may have communicated with each LEA and Charter school indicating they should verify school and contact information in the Advanced Website System (AWS). This communication was sent in error. As a service, the NCDPI will provide updated school and OCR contact information on behalf of the public schools in North Carolina; therefore, LEAs and Charter schools do not need to verify the school and contact information in the AWS. An updated schools list has already been sent to the OCR in preparation of the upcoming collection.

The NCDPI requested that all Districts and Charters verify and update/add an Office of Civil Rights Coordinator and a Student Information Coordinator contact in the EDDIE system by Friday, September 9, 2016. Due to challenges with the EDDIE system last week, the NCDPI will extend the deadline to close of business Wednesday, September 21, 2016.
