Industry Certifications and Credentials Teacher Bonuses Session Law 2017-57 Section 8.9 2017-18

SL 2017-57 modified the industry certifications and credentials teacher bonus program. Modifications made:

- 1. Includes all public school teachers (LEAs, charter schools, regional school, Lab schools)
- 2. Maximum award per teacher increased to \$3,500
- 3. Removes the requirement to teach a certification or credential courses in the following year to be eligible.

The bonus is NOT subject to retirement. It is subject to Social Security. Coding is as follows:

CTE Credentials 1-5120-048-180

Procedure

Bonus of \$25 or \$50 for each student taught by a teacher who provided instruction in a course that led to the attainment of an industry certification or credential.

Teacher may receive a maximum bonus of \$3,500 per year.

DPI will

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- Provide the entities with the SBE approved value of the bonus for each credential/certification
- Provide a list of the teachers with the associated credentials/certifications
- Allot funds to each entity based on the total number of credentials/certification multiplied by the appropriate value (plus social security). This is an estimated allotment and should be in excess of what is needed.

The LEAs are responsible for:

- Validating that the teacher is still working in the same LEA, charter school, regional school or lab school in the current year
- Calculating the bonus amount for each teacher.
- Ensuring the bonus does not exceed \$3,500
- Paying the teachers for the bonus in January 2018.
