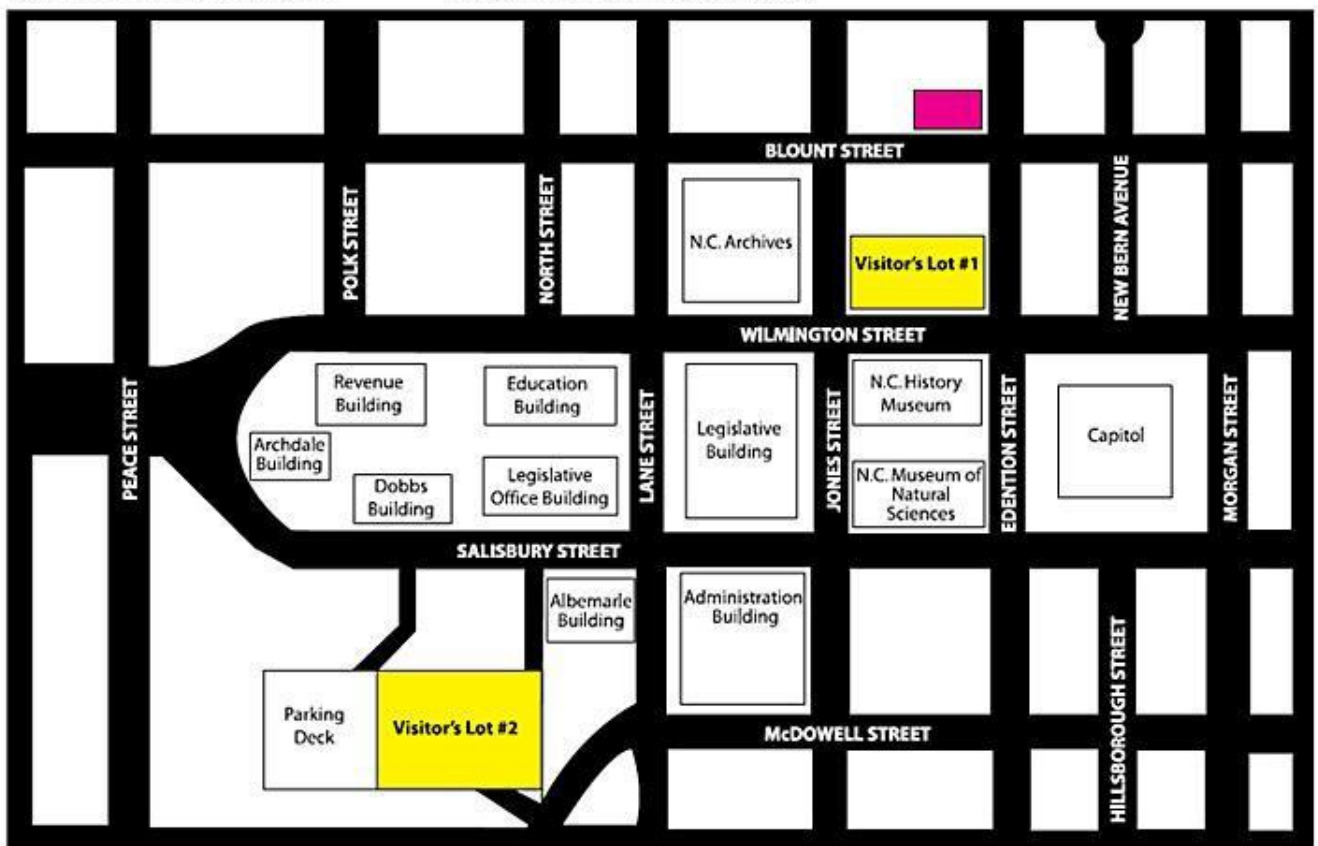
**Visitor Lot #1**
