- **3.** Why are you initiating a contract? What services will you require? In-school nursing services provided for a student who is medically complex and fragile, requiring support while in transit and at school, for circulation monitoring and continuous tube feeds.

Providing inschool nursing services for this student will allow her access to the curriculum in a language-rich environment, where she can develop interpersonal communication, learn the culture of school, have access to capable professionals able to mediate her experiences, and be stimulated in the six domains of learning for early childhood.

This position is needed to provide full-time support to a medically complex and fragile student, so that she may attend school. Current school nursing positions at NC School for the Deaf cover all students for first aid, referrals, and medication administration. No personnel are available to devote full-time nursing care for a single, medically complex and fragile student.
