"Students from low-income families" is a term used in section 312(d) of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021.

[2] Reimbursement to a non-public school for costs the school incurred to address the impact of COVID-19 was a previously authorized service under section 312(d)(4)(M) of the CRRSA Act.
