The EC Alert will notify the user that the student is an exceptional student (EC) student. The alert shows in the Admin Portal on all student screens and in the Teacher Portal on the Student Backpack screens.

The alert appears under the following conditions:

- 1. The **Program/Services Begin Date** must be before today's date
- 2. The Primary Disability must have a value
- **3.** Either the **Exit Date** and **Exit Reason** fields must be blank, or **Exit Date** exists with an **Exit Reason** in {'di', 'do', 'gr', 'mv', 'ma', 'cp'}

The alert appears under the following conditions:

1. During the current year (as defined by the term set at the top of the page), the EL Status must be Current

The M1 Alert will notify the user that the student is a Monitored Former English Learner student. Specifically, the student is in the first year of monitoring. The alert shows in the Admin Portal on all student screens and in the Teacher Portal on the Student Backpack screens.

The alert appears under the following conditions:

- 1. During the current year (as defined by the term set at the top of the page), the EL Status must be Exited
- 2. The students **exited school year** subtracted from the **current school year** must equal 1.

The alert appears with the other alerts in the student header section. See Figure 7. M1 Alert in Admin Portal and Figure 8. M1 Alert in Teacher Portal.

The alert appears under the following conditions:

- 1. During the current year (as defined by the term set at the top of the page), the EL Status must be Exited
- 2. The students **exited school year** subtracted from the **current school year** must equal 2.

- 1. During the current year (as defined by the term set at the top of the page), the EL Status must be Exited
- 2. The students **exited school year** subtracted from the **current school year** must equal 3.

Admin Portal on all student screens and in the Teacher Portal on the Student Backpack screens.

The alert appears under the following conditions:

- 1. During the current year (as defined by the term set at the top of the page), the EL Status must be Exited
- 2. The students **exited school year** subtracted from the **current school year** must equal 4.

AIG Alert

The AIG Alert will notify the user that the student is an academically or intelligently gifted (AIG) student. The alert shows in the Admin Portal on all student screens and in the Teacher Portal on the Student Backpack screens.

The alert appears under the following conditions:

- 1. Student's AIG Identification must be one of the following values {Academically Gifted Math Only, Academically Gifted Reading Only, Academically and Intellectually Gifted, Academically Gifted, Intellectually Gifted}
- 2. The School Placement Date must be before today
- 3. Either the AIG withdrawal Date must be blank, or the AIG withdrawal Date must be after today.

0 Military Alert

The Military Alert will notify the user that the student is a military connected student. The alert shows in the Admin Portal on all student screens (via the NCDPI Military plugin) and in the Teacher Portal on the Student Backpack screens.

The alert appears under the following conditions:

- 1. On the Military Connected Students screen, the answer to "Is student military connected?" is set to Yes.
- **2.** One or more family members will be connected.

Note:

The alert appears with the other alerts in the student header section. See Figure 11. Military Alert in Admin Portal and Figure 12. Military Alert in Teacher Portal.

The icon rotates through the different military branch seals.
