School Nutrition funds cannot be used to supplement adult meals for school employees outside of the School Nutrition Program. During the review, a report was generated on January 14, 2019 showing a charge of \$66.50 and was reduced to \$22.00 on January 16, 2019 by adults outside the School Nutrition Program at Columbus Charter School. This amount must be refunded to the non-profit School Nutrition account. In the 2017-2018 school year, the school had bad debt (student meal charges) in the amount of \$180.60. This amount was repaid to the School Nutrition Program on November 30, 2018. The School Nutrition Program cannot carry forward bad debt beyond September 30th of the prior school year.
