Finding Detail: Breakfast - Production Records for five (5) days for the week of review (December 13-17, 2021), documented insufficient fruit offerings at breakfast. Students must be offered one (1) cup of fruit at breakfast; however, the production record recorded one-half (1/2) cup of fruit offered/available to students. Lunch - Production Records for four (4) days for the week of review (December 13-17, 2021), documented insufficient vegetable offerings at lunch. Students must be offered three quarter (3/4) cup of vegetables at lunch; however, the production record recorded one-half (1/2) cup of vegetable offered/available to students. Students were not offered a variety of milk daily at breakfast. Two (2) different milk varieties must be offered throughout service daily.

Offer versus Serve (OVS) (provision that allows students to decline some of the food components offered) – Validation of the SFA's compliance with OVS requirements, if applicable

Finding Detail: Production records specify participation in Offer versus Serve at lunch; however, patterns in numbers of meal items served on production records indicate students are not able to decline food components.
