• Cashier Cash Records were not included with the paperwork on multiple days, and when present, many entries lacked the required two signatures, often showing either no signature or only one. • Deposits were not consistently completed by the last day of the month; for example, the September 2025 deposit was combined with October dates, and the November 2025 deposit was also included with October transactions. • The \$250 deposit limit was exceeded multiple times.
