The North Carolina Early Learning Sensory Support Program 2021-2022 Assurances and Request for Services Documents

The North Carolina Early Learning Sensory Support Program (ELSSP) within the Sensory Support and Assistive Technology Section has updated the Request for Services and Assurance documents for the 2021-2022 school year. Although the ELSSP primarily serves children and families under Part C of IDEA, when capacity is available and in locations that do not have qualified staff and are in primarily rural areas, the ELSSP may serve children with hearing or vision impairments ages three to five under IDEA Part B. An additional goal of the ELSSP Assurances is to support the Local Education Agency (LEA) to build capacity to serve students beyond age five so that contracting services, which are often costly, may not be necessary.

The attached forms are required if an LEA desires to make a request for the ELSSP to provide specially designed instruction for a student age three to five with a vision or hearing loss. The request will be reviewed and within 14 days a response will be provided to the LEA.
