To be determined eligible in the disability category of Traumatic Brain Injury, the following must be documented:

Characteristic		Documentation/Summary
	Written verification, by a licensed physician or a licensed psychologist, appropriately practicing in the specialty of neuropsychology, which documents the child has sustained an injury from which brain injury can be inferred.	
	Current (within one year) psychological evaluation for traumatic brain injury conducted by appropriately licensed school psychologist or psychologist licensed in the specialty of neuropsychology who also meets the guidelines of the EC Division for the assessment of children with TBI and is listed on the registry of approved providers.
