



## 21DC Definitions

- **Center/Site** – A center/site supported with 21st CCLC funds is the physical location where grant-funded services and activities are provided to participating students and adults. A center/site is characterized by defined hours of operation, a dedicated staff that plans, facilitates, and supervises program activities. The terms are used interchangeably.
- **Feeder School** – A school from which 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC participants are drawn.
- **Grantee** – Fiscal agent of a 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC grant
- **21DC** – NC state based collection system for 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC data
- **Home Base / PowerSchool** – North Carolina’s information system that contains all NC public school attendees’ data
- **CA** – Confidentiality Agreement; required before data entry can occur in 21DC
- **NCDPI** – North Carolina Department of Public Instruction
- **Objectives** – Defined by Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA)

- **Regular Attendees** – Students who have attended a 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC program for at least 30 days (do not have to be consecutive) during the reporting period.
- **State-level data** – Information about DPI’s 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC activities
- **Student-level data** – Student-specific 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC data (Privacy Act-protected)
- **Teacher Survey** – Administered toward the end of the school year, this survey asks (public) feeder school teachers to report on academic and social behavior of 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC students identified as “regular attendees.” One teacher survey is completed for each student identified as a regular attendee.
