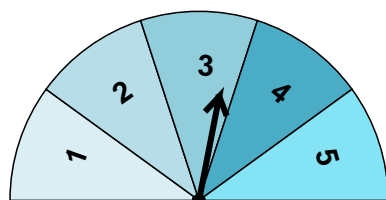

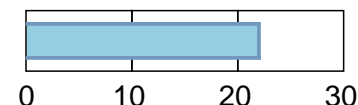

## Student's Score

There are fifteen items (five English language arts/reading items, five mathematics items, and five science items) on the NCEXTEND1 Grade 11 Alternate Assessment. Students are provided up to two opportunities to respond to each item, and items are scored on a 0-2-point scale, with a maximum of 30 points total.

There are five achievement levels reported (1, 2, 3, 4, and 5). The student is assigned an achievement level based on his or her total score. The achievement level indicated whether the student's score is **proficient** (Yes) or **not proficient** (No). An achievement level of 3, 4, or 5 indicates that the student is proficient in the grade-level knowledge and skills assessed by the test. An achievement level of 1 or 2 indicates the student is not proficient in grade-level knowledge and skills assessed by the test and will likely need academic support to be successful in these content areas in the future.
