A State Educational Agen

A State Educational Agency (SEA) or Local Education Agency (LEA) shall use Federal funds received under Title I, Part A only to supplement the funds that would, in the absence of such Federal funds, be made available from State and Local sources for the education of students participating in programs assisted under Title I, Part A and not to supplant such funds. ESEA Section 1118(b)(1)

Carryover: Section 1127(a) of the ESEA prohibits a LEA from carrying over to the next fiscal year more than 15 percent of its

Title I, Part A allocation if the LEA's Title I Allocation equals or exceeds \$50,000. Section 1127(b) permits a SEA to waive this limitation once every three years if the LEAs request is reasonable and necessary; or a supplemental Title I appropriation becomes available.
