The purpose of this program is to:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(1) Increase student achievement consistent with challenging State academic standards.</li><li>(2) Improve the quality and effectiveness of teachers, principals, and other school leaders.</li><li>(3) Increase the number of teachers, principals, and other school leaders who are effective in improving student academic achievement in schools.</li><li>(4) Provide low-income and minority students greater access to effective teachers, principals, and other school leaders.</li></ul>

Grant Rules or Special Spending Provisions:	There are no limits for administrative costs.

<b>Carryover:</b>	Funds that have not been spent as originally obligated by the district. Title IIA funds are made available on July 1 of the fiscal year and remain available for obligation for a period of 27 months.
